

2009-2010 HUSKERLAND WRESTLING YOUTH OFFICIAL'S APPLICATION

A. Mail \$10 check and this application to Chuck Sherer (3501 88th Street, Columbus, Nebraska 68601) to obtain a current rule book and rules test. **(Note: You must apply to participate in the Youth Official's Program each year!)** Applicants must turn 16 years of age by March 1st in order to apply.

B. Return completed rules test by January 23, 2010. This is an open book test and you are encouraged to seek advice from others on questions you're not sure about.

C. Must score at least a 70% on the test to pass. Successful applicants will be mailed a 2010 Youth Official's acceptance and mentor information. First year officials will receive a Huskerland Wrestling Youth Official's Patch to wear on the left breast your official uniform shirt.

D. Successful applicants will have their name, address, and phone number placed on the Huskerland Wrestling website. This information is available for club directors looking for officials to work their events. We also encourage you to contact club directors from the Huskerland Web-site and request consideration to work their events.

E. In order to work as a Young Official, successful applicants must obtain the following uniform items: grey & black striped uniform shirt, whistle & black lanyard, red/green colored flip disk, red and green arm bands, and black pants (black shorts are acceptable).

F. Club directors are encouraged to pay \$10 per hour for Youth Officials. They are also encouraged to hire NSAA Officials that have agreed to mentor Youth Officials at their club meets.

G. In order to work the Huskerland State Wrestling Tournament, Youth Officials must work at least three club meets during the season. Youth Officials selected to work the State Tournament will be selected based on the evaluations submitted by their NSAA Mentors and comments from Club directors and Coaches. Youth Officials selected to work the two-day event will receive payment for services. Lodging & Lunch meals are provided.
